Tuberculosis is still rampant in the Eastern Cape Province of South Africa.

We certainly see our fair share of it in the Itipini Community clinic.

Many patients are repeating their treatment as they did not complete their first. This requires more extensive treatment, including a series of daily injections.



Zanethemba and Lizwi are brothers and both have TB. They come to the clinic every day for their injections.

Many of our patients, like Mandla, are also HIV-positive. Some are too weak to make it to the clinic for their treatment so we bring it to them in their shack. He lives alone in this shack.
